

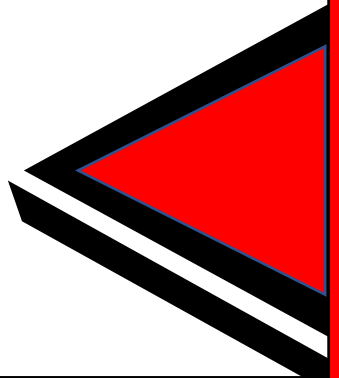

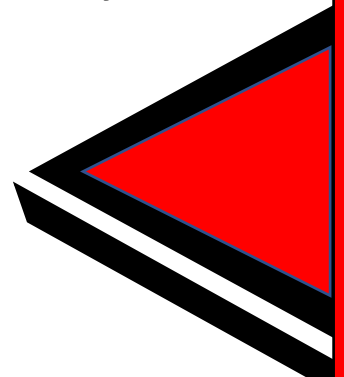

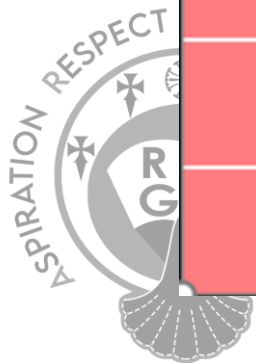
# The Power of Partnership

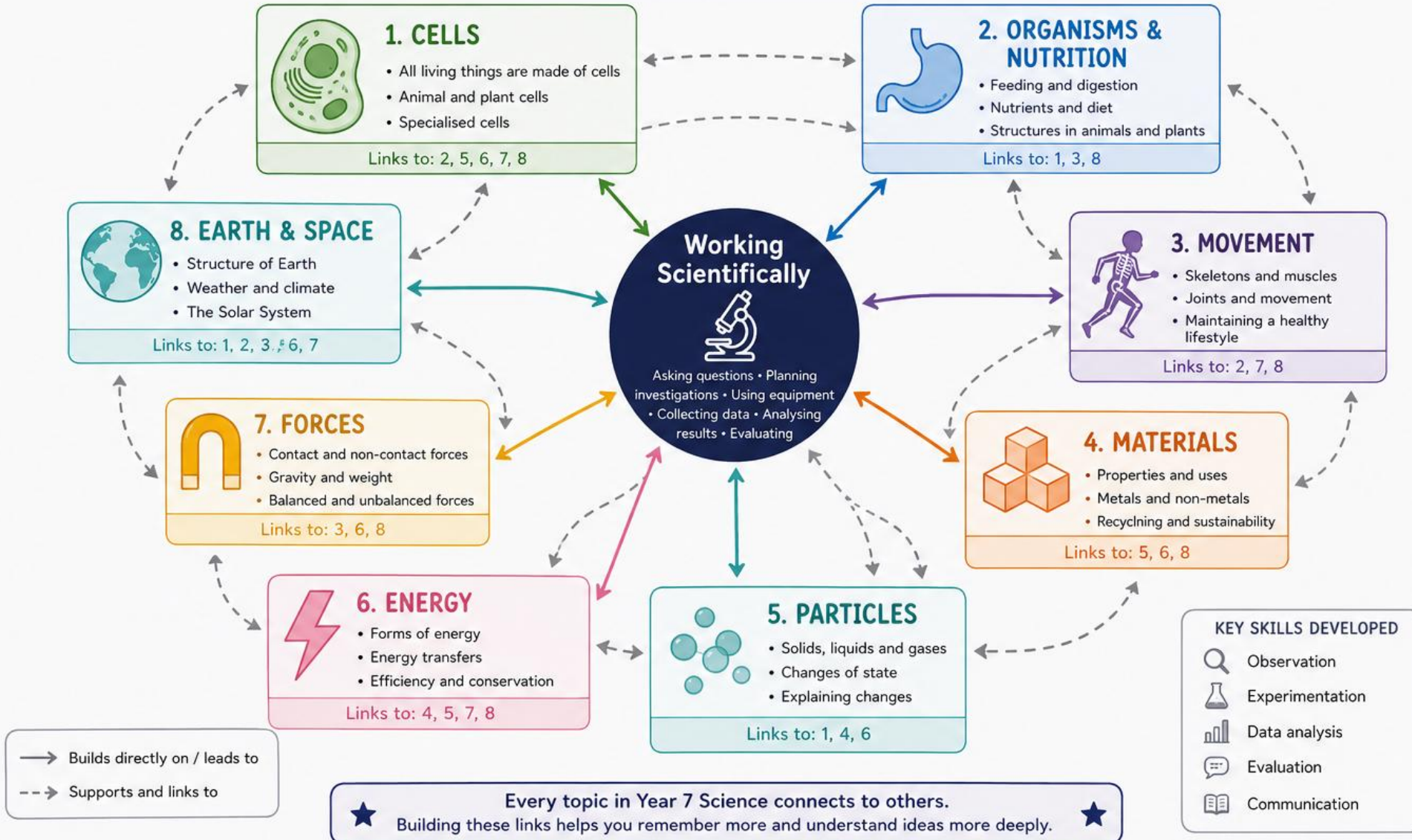
# Attendance

# Typical School Day



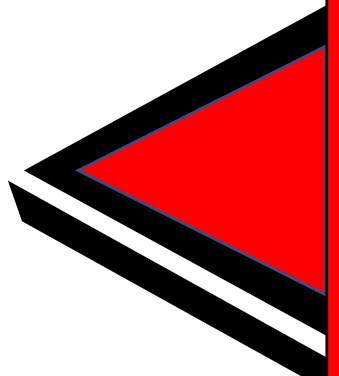
- Arrive School from **7:55am**

# Teams and Homework



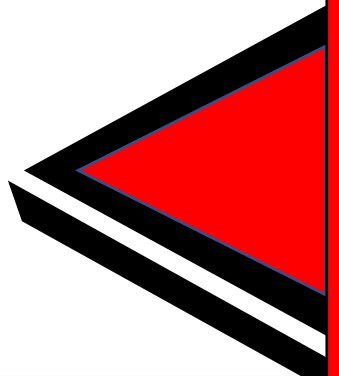
- **Students will be given a Homework timetable** (maximum amount of homework a night 3).

- **Teams/SharePoint** to share resources etc with the children



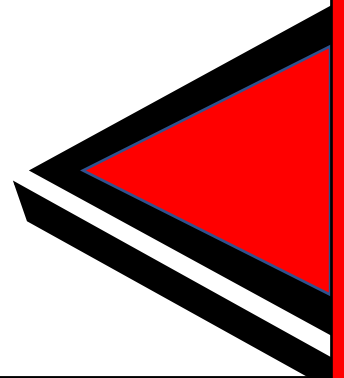

# September 2026

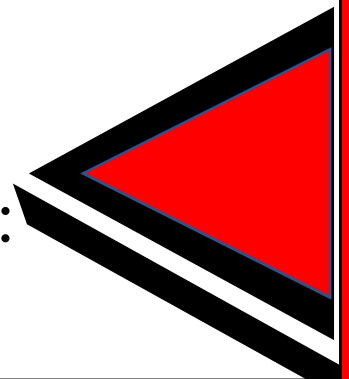


- School starts Wednesday 2nd Sept.
