

## KS4 History

The GCSE History course is divided into four units, each of which is worth 25% of your final grade:

**Unit 1: A Development Study** – you will learn about the history of Medicine and Public Health from Roman Britain to the present day and the key developments which have taken place.



**Unit 2: A Depth Study** – you will learn about the American West from c1840 - c1895 and how it was transformed.

**Unit 3: A Source Enquiry** – by studying the development of surgery from c1845-1918, you will learn about how sources are used as evidence in history and how historians carry out their researches.

**Unit 4: Representations of History** - through studying Russia from 1917 - 1941, you will learn how and why historians produce different interpretations of the past.

Units 1, 2 and 3 will be assessed through examinations at the end of Year 11; Unit 4 will be assessed through classroom-controlled tasks to be completed at the beginning of Year 11. We are sure you will find this a varied and stimulating course, with the unit on Russia introducing you to some of the work we study in greater detail at A Level.
