Kickstart Government Scheme

I am pleased to advise you that the Government's new Kickstart initiative is now live on Gov.uk

This £2 billion programme will fund the direct creation of additional jobs for young people at risk of long-term unemployment, to improve their chances of progressing to find long-term, sustainable work.

The funding available is for each job and the Government will pay the National Minimum Wage rate for 25 hours a week for each employee, plus the associated employer National Insurance contributions and employer minimum automatic enrolment contributions. The fund will also award £1500 to an employer for each Kickstart job placement, to support with training the individual as well as helping pay other set-up costs.

The placements on offer must be for additional job roles and not for roles that would have otherwise been advertised, or to replace an existing employee. The first job placements are expected to begin in November.

If you can offer a smaller number of placements (i.e. less than 30) you will need to apply for the fund via a representative, who will be responsible for registering you on the scheme. If you are applying on behalf of a group of employers, you can get £300 of funding for each job placement to support with the associated administrative costs of bringing these employers together.
