School Fund donations

The School (fund) has charitable status and therefore is able to reclaim tax on a donation made by a UK tax payer.

The School can reclaim from the Government an extra £0.25 for every £1 you have donated (based on current basic rate of income tax). The School Fund at present is £15 per school year and assuming your child remains at school for seven years, the tax which could be claimed back would amount to £26.25 per student.
