You are the author of your work and so do not put any limits to your imagination. For 30 minutes you have equipment at your disposal as well as teacher's guidance and suggestions.

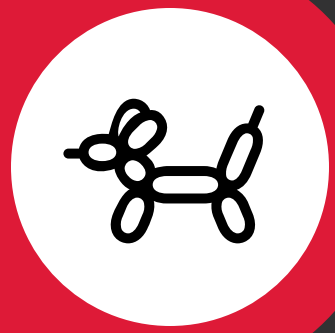
